
# NORTH BRISBANE LAPIDARY CLUB 2024 Peter Smith Memorial Challenge Cabbing – Level One (Club) – OPEN

### Section 2A Double Standard Cabochon




**DOUBLE STANDARD CABOCHON** 

A stone cut from a single piece of Natural Lapidary material, not laminated in any form. Polished on all surfaces and entirely hand worked, not machine faceted. Grinding and sanding shall be done on FLAT faced laps, wheels, or drums.

Stone must be domed on both sides. Where these two surfaces meet, the Girdle Line must be a distinct finely radiused edge (having a rounded or curved edge), assessable under allowable magnification and which is clearly identifiable as the division between the two surfaces and which, when viewed from the side, must be straight, not wavy, or flat.

The two domed surfaces do not have to be the same height.



Bull-nosed or flat girdles will render the entry ineligible.

## This Year's Criteria

- Natural lapidary material: Rhodonite (material available at the club to buy)
- Size and shape: Oval outline when viewed from above

#### Judging

The competition will be judged in accordance with the rules and definitions of the Competitor & Judging Manual for Lapidary and Allied Competitions Issue No.8 April 2015. A summary is provided below but for more information check out a copy of the manual in the club library.

Maximum 3 entries per person


