### Section 26B Enamelled Jewellery without Mount

Enamelled Jewellery in which the backing material may be bought or formed by the entrant. Commercial spacer beads and caps are permitted in enamelled necklaces and bracelets, provided they do not dominate, and they will not be judged. Items will be judged on Aesthetic Appaeal, creativity, Enamelling Technique and Finish. Entries MUST be functional, (have a point of suspension). Transfers are not permitted.

The competition will be judged in accordance with the rules and definitions of the Competitor & Judging Manual for Lapidary and Allied Competitions Issue No.8 April 2015. A summary is provided below but for more information check out a copy of the manual in the club library.
