Section 1A Standard Cabochon

A stone cut from a single piece of Natural Lapidary material, not laminated in any form. Polished on all surfaces and entirely hand worked, not machine faceted. Grinding and sanding shall be done on FLAT faced laps, wheels, or drums.

- Must have a domed top, flat back, and back bevel
- Must be polished on all surfaces including back bevel
- Height must not exceed 50% of the width of the stone
- Must have a girdle line and may have a top set bevel

- Natural lapidary material: Dendritic Opalite (available for purchase at the club)
- Size and shape: Oval (templates are available at the club).
